

Catch up Funding

In response to the government catch up funding, Stone Soup Academy received £8,000 in June 2021

We are very conscious about the time lost during lockdown and the current situation that we all find ourselves in. In order to better support your young people we have put in place additional support as detailed below:-

- Toe by Toe synthetic reading strategy to increase levels of literacy in students identified as having decreased during lock down. (£400)
- Access to technology and connectivity

23 allocated periods per week over 6 weeks in term 6 to support targeted students (£8970)

- Additional support to meet an individual pupil's needs
- Sustained, targeted support
- Accelerated catch-up learning for pupils who've fallen behind
- Intense tutoring and mentoring
- 1-on-1 or small group tutoring

Our interventions are personalised to each student and are based and supported by case studies and robust data analysis.

Impact

June 2021 - August 2021

High attendance (79.2%) of students attending the academy.

Table 6 shows that year 10 progress in all subjects. All internal subjects apart from music are in line with the whole cohort. 58% of subjects in all subjects are exceeding their BKSB targets by the end of year 11. The students on the external courses are making great progress.
